# JHA's & "Routine Operations"

## What does "Routine" mean?

- Habitual, mechanical, regular, repetitious, normal
- Routine tasks can still be high risk
- Jumping out of airplanes is "routine" for a skydiver
- Need to stop and go through some type of checklist:
  - Do I have a parachute on?
  - Do I know how to open it?
  - Are we high enough to jump?
  - Have I ever done this before?



# Standard Operating Procedures

## So what if we have a SOP?

- Does it capture all the Hazards?
- Does it control all the Hazards?
- Does it have “hold points”?
- Does it call for a JHA for changed conditions?



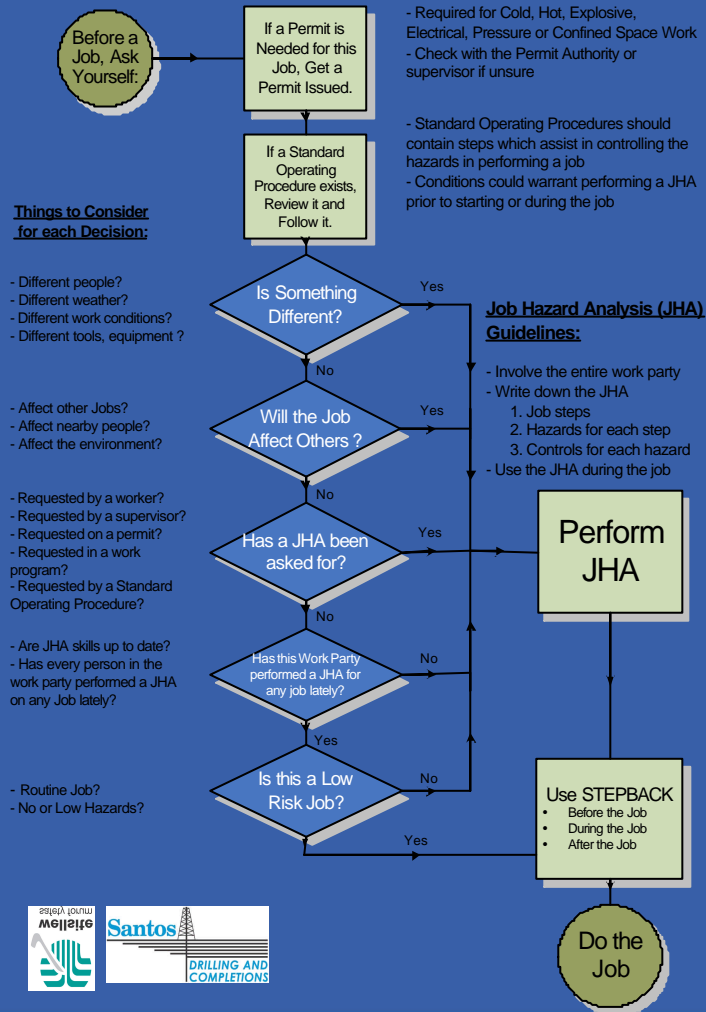
# JHA's & Permits to Work

- Permit systems mainly for work scheduling/planning, certainly assist in improving safety
- Even with a Permit, still need to perform JHA
- Consider making it mandatory to perform a JHA with every permit for a period of time, until it becomes “part of your normal operations”
